Kay Arthur is an internationally-respected Bible teacher, author, speaker, missionary, and radio and television host who has made significant contributions to the worldwide Christian community. Arthur spends much of her time traveling throughout the world teaching people how to study the Bible.

In 1970, she and her husband, Jack, founded Precept Ministries International. What began as a fledgling ministry for teens is now a worldwide outreach organization. Precept classes are taught in all 50 states, and Precept's inductive Bible studies, now available in 70 languages and 150 countries, are used in dozens of Bible colleges and seminaries throughout the world.

More than five million copies of Arthur's 100-plus books and Bible studies are in print today, and several have received the prestigious Gold Medallion Award, including *A Marriage Without Regrets*; *The International Inductive Study Bible*; *His Imprint, My Expression*; and *Lord, I Need Grace to Make It*. Other books named as Gold Medallion finalists are *Israel, My Beloved*; *As Silver Refined*; *That I May Know Him*; *God, Are You There?*; *My Savior, My Friend*; *Beloved*; *With an Everlasting Love*; and *The New Inductive Study Series*.

In *Youniquely Woman*, Kay Arthur, Emilie Barnes, and Donna Otto team up to offer women "been there, done that" wisdom gleaned through the journey of their lives. Sharing what they most wish they had known as wives, mothers, and women of God, they help other women experience more peace at home, a stronger relationship with God, and balance in every area of life. *Youniquely Woman* will help readers discover how they can live intentionally, pursue a path of excellence, and ultimately be used of God beyond their expectations and dreams. Arthur reaches millions of viewers and listeners through the programs *Precepts for Life*, and *Precepts from God's Word*, aired on approximately 800 television and radio stations worldwide and on the internet at Precept.org. 
Interview Questions

for Kay Arthur, author of *Youniquely Woman*


- What is the story behind *Youniquely Woman*? How did you, Emilie Barnes, and Donna Otto happen to coauthor this book?
