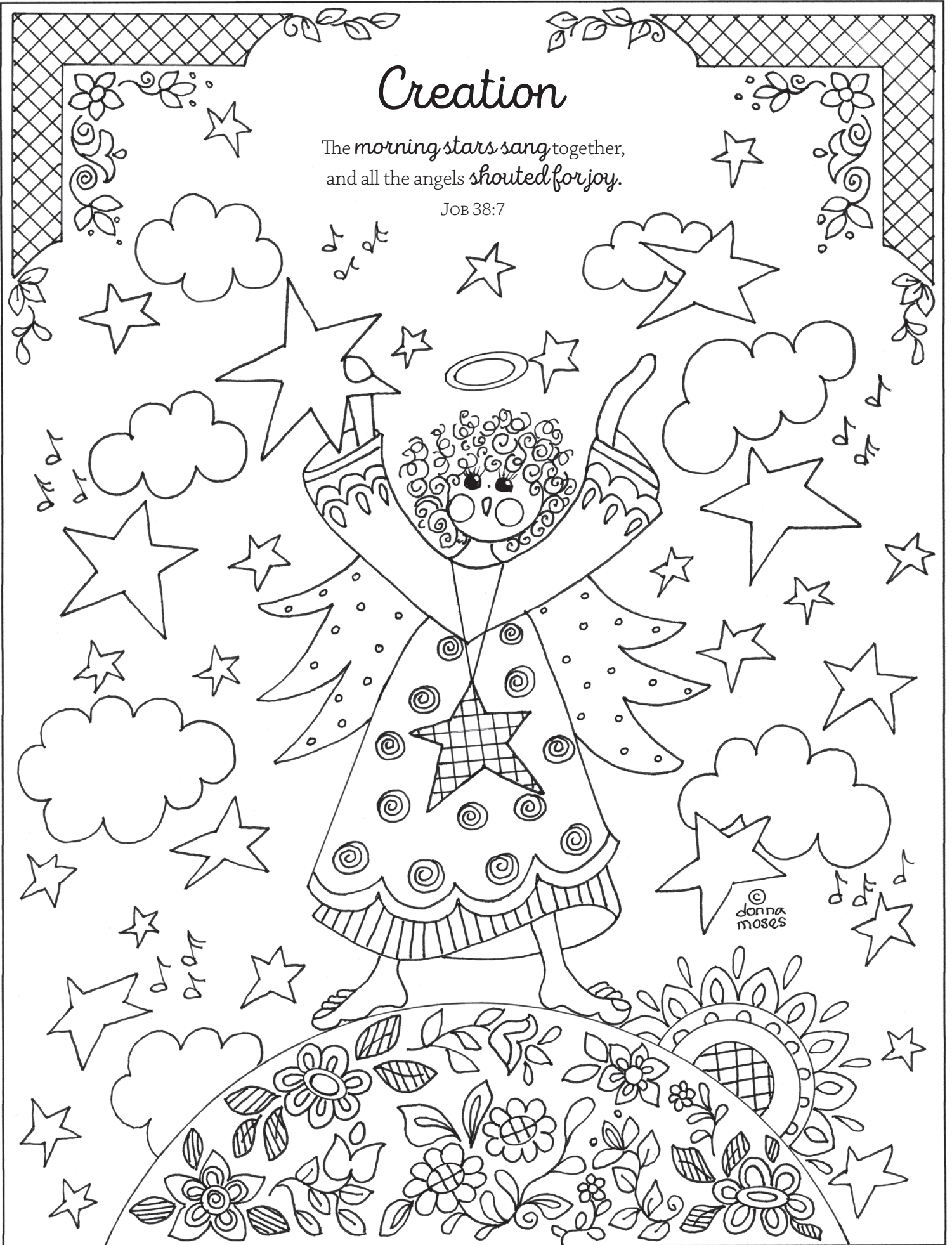

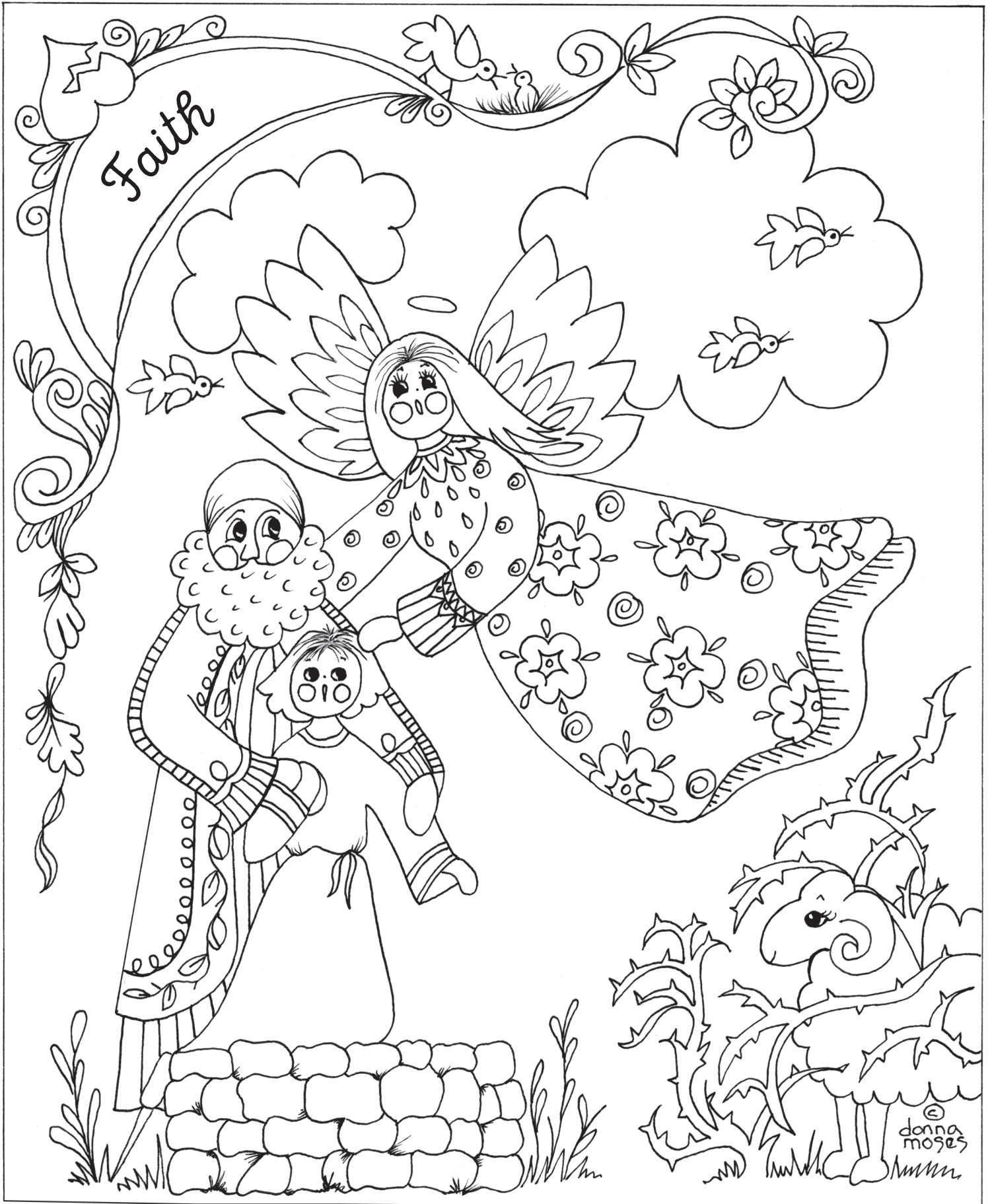

Rescue



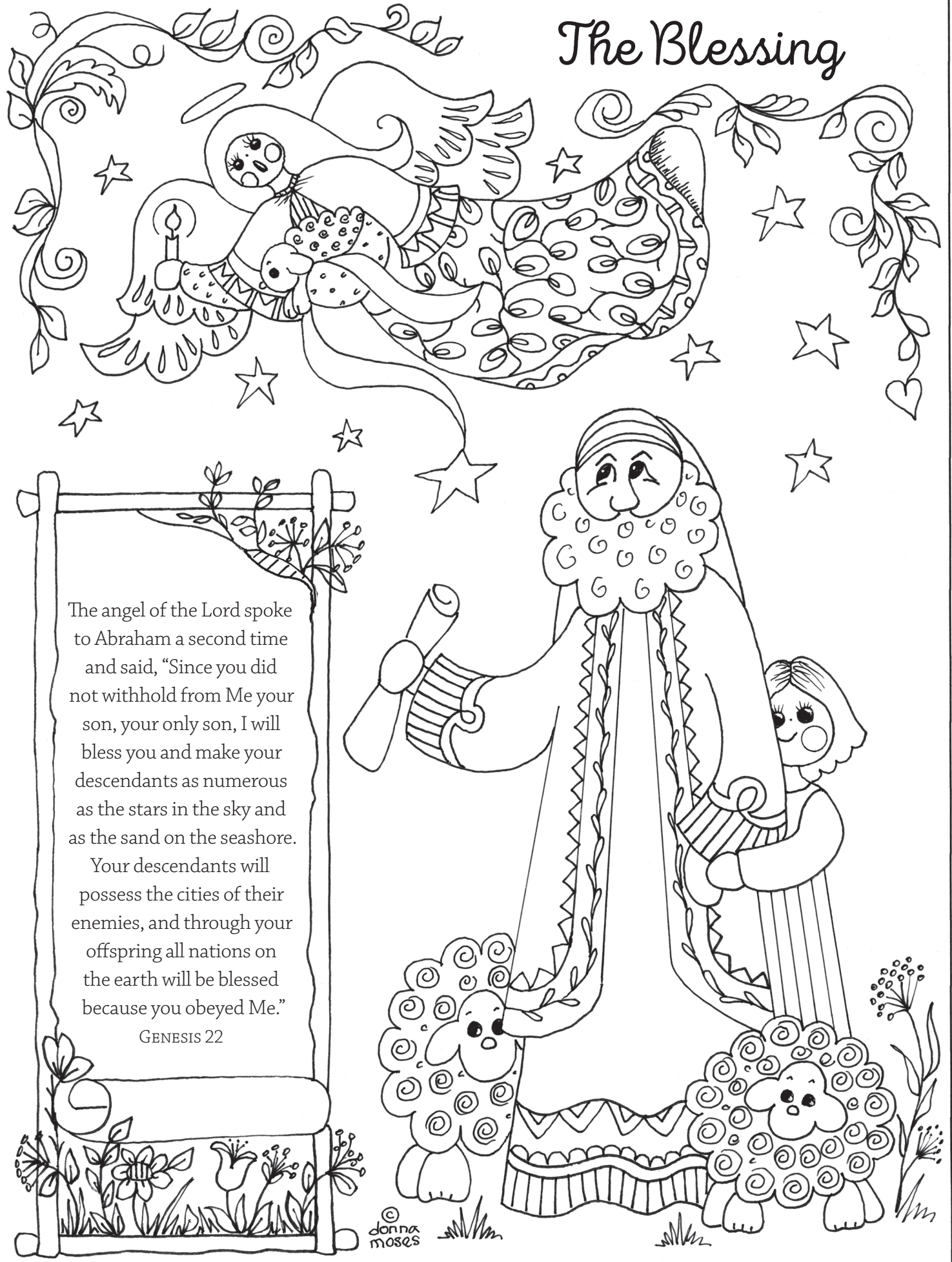

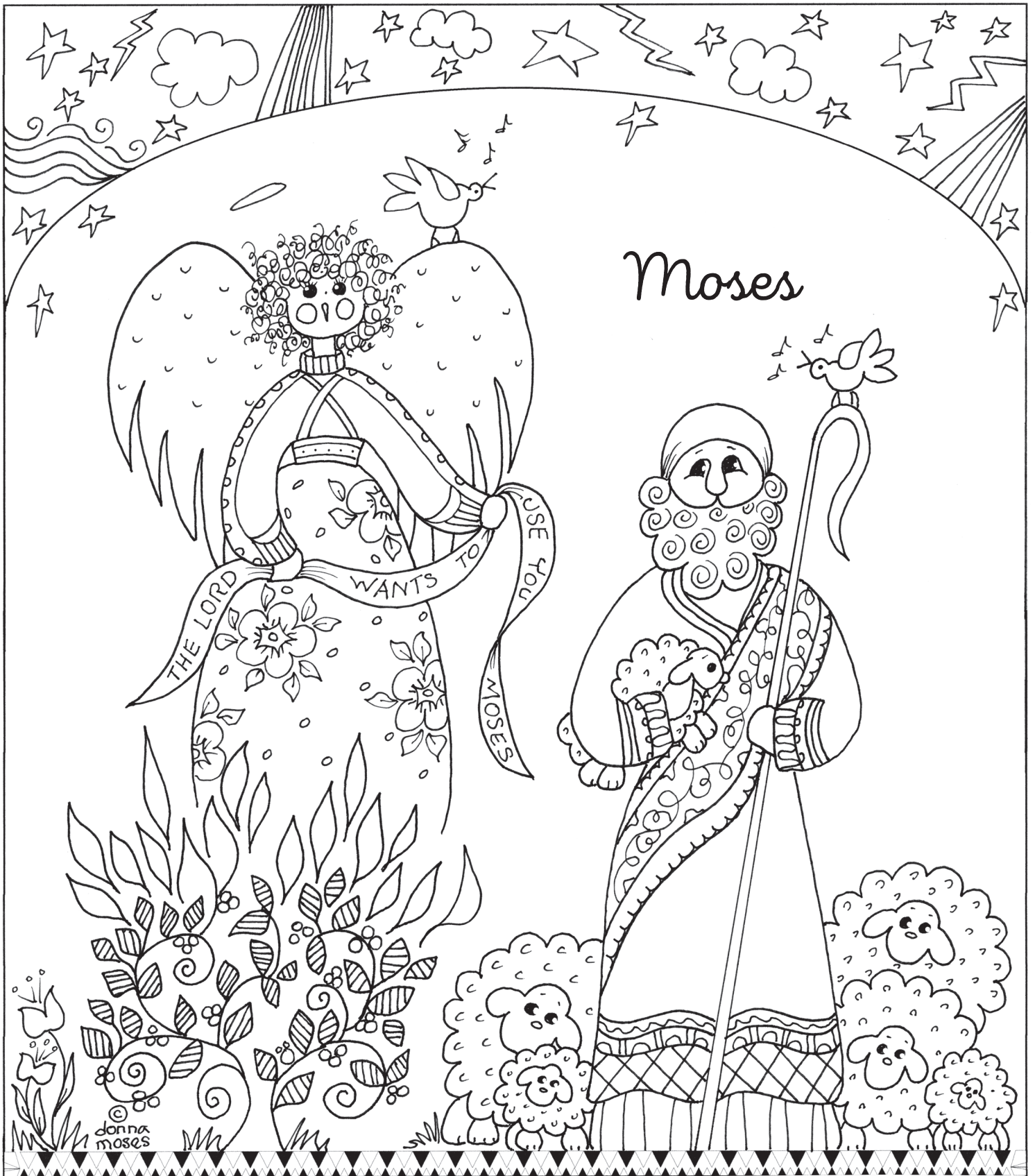
