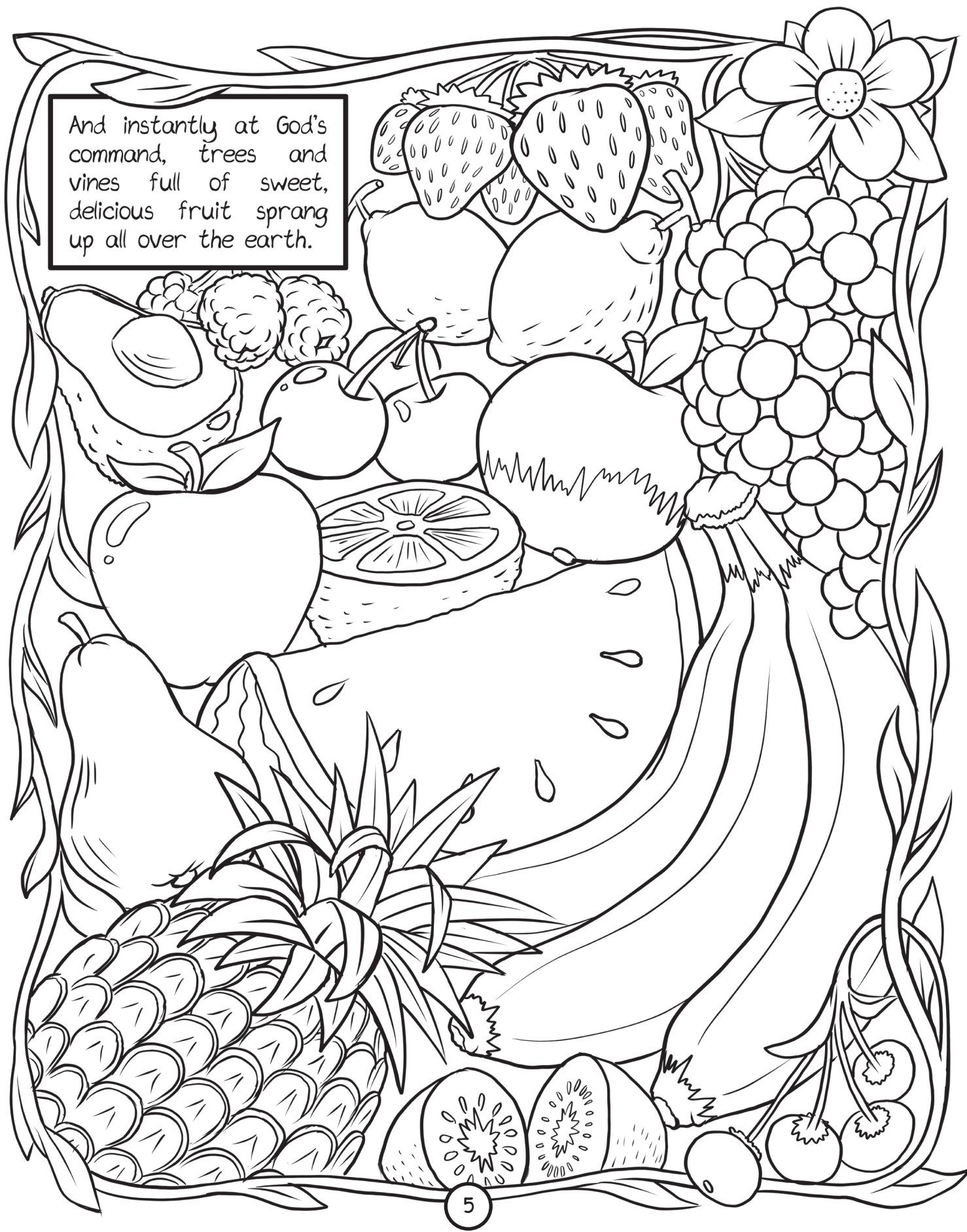
Let the waters be divided, and let the dry land appear.
