“I’ll help you find your classroom,” J2 promised.





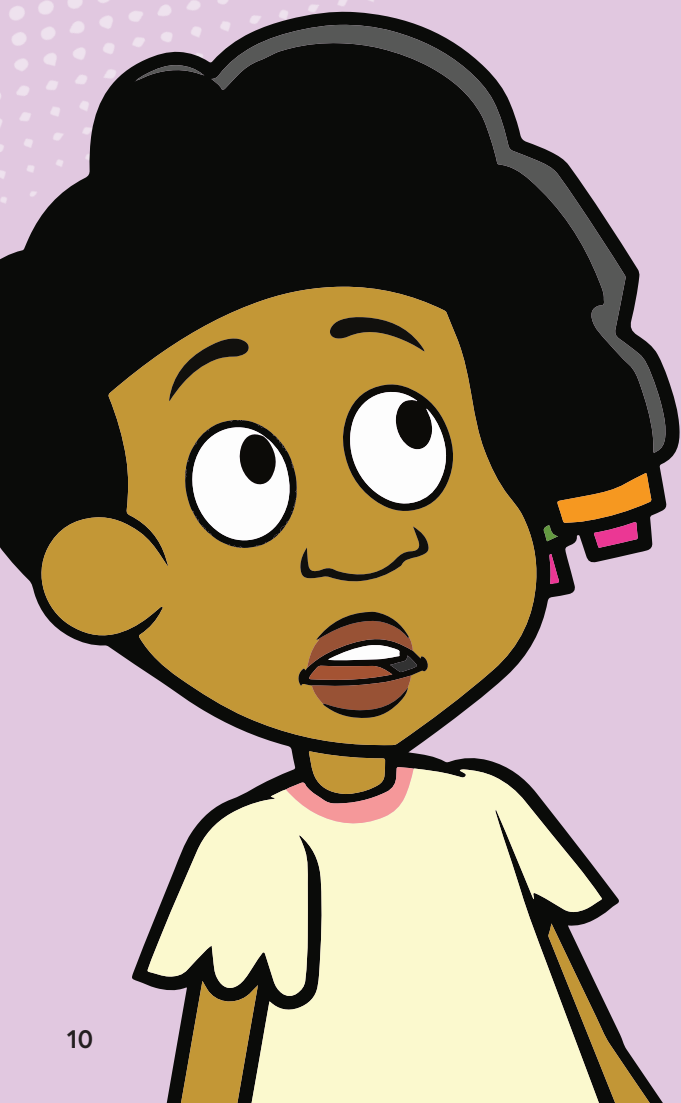
“Yeah, and I’ll help you learn your way around the school,” Kelsey announced.

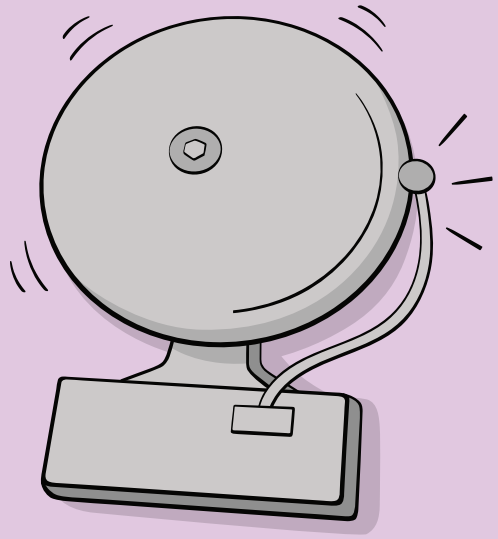
“And I’ll play with you on the playground!” proclaimed Kam.
