

don't know how to be the perfect parent for my children," I said to God in desperation one day. "I need You to help me raise them."

God responded by impressing on my heart the following words: If you are not covering your children in prayer every day, you are leaving their lives to chance.

What a frightening thought!

"Then teach me how to pray for my children the way You would have me to, Lord," I said.

I hope this book will be a helpful reminder to keep your children covered in prayer. I know you'll agree that leaving their lives to chance is not good enough.

You alone know what he (she) needs. I release him (her) to You to care for and protect, and I commit myself to pray for everything concerning him (her) that I can think of or that You put upon my heart.

Teach me how to pray and guide me in what to pray about. Help me not to impose my own will when I'm praying for him (her), but rather enable me to pray that Your will be done in his (her) life. Thank You that I can partner with You in raising him (her) and that I don't have to do it alone.

Securing Protection from Harm

Lord, I lift (<u>name of child</u>) up to You and ask that You would put a hedge of protection around her (him). Protect her (his) spirit, body, mind, and emotions from any kind of evil or harm.

I pray specifically for protection from accidents, disease, injury, or any other physical, mental, or emotional abuse.

I pray that she (he) will make her (his) refuge "in the shadow of Your wings" until "these calamities have passed by" (Psalm 57:1).

Hide her (him) from any kind of evil influences that would come against her (him).

When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow you. When you walk through the fire, you shall not be burned, nor shall the flame scorch you.
